Creating an Access Level– Axiom X

• At the top of the Axiom X software, select **Database** and then Access Level.



• select **New** at the top left of the window.

- Enter the name of your access level, we have used Master in this example as you may well want to set it up like this to test all the doors when commissioning.
- Under Access Level Type if you are unsure select 'Both' this will mean it is available for multiple configurations.
